- Cow Cutouts
- Manipulative Dots

Directions: Print these cows and allow children to practice solving problems. Enhance problem solving by presenting the students with a scenario and allowing them to try to solve the problem before modeling.

Example Problem – “One day there were two cows who were best friends. Together they had a total of 4 spots. They were jumping on a trampoline and when they go off, somehow all their spots had fallen off! They both had the same number of spots but we can't figure out how many they both had. If we don't give them the same number, they will be sad. Can you help both cows get the right number of spots again?”
